- Creates and/or edit written content for annual campaign appeals as needed at the direction of the Director of Development Communication.
- Assists in the creation and management of case statements and associated materials for capital improvements to the Zoo.
- Composes endowment and stewardship reports and manage the reporting schedule, including reports to foundations, government agencies, corporation partners, and individual donors.
- Works with Development staff and other Zoo staff to assist with their writing and editing projects as needed (e.g., mass marketing emails, event invitations, presentation slide desks, and presentation talking points.
- Collaboratively develops goals, objectives and strategies for foundation support with Manager of Development Operations and Research.
- Creates and updates programmatic content for Development webpages as needed.
- Creates and update donor acknowledgement/stewardship letter templates.
